While I'm Away and Consequences

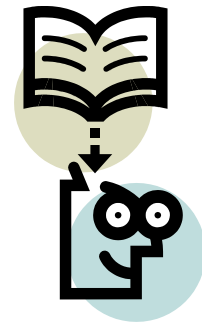
